James Cook Hotel Grand Chancellor Supports I Love Fiji Cyclone Relief Concert

The James Cook Hotel Grand Chancellor is proud to support the I Love Fiji Cyclone Relief Concert, held this Saturday 21 May from 6pm at the Michael Fowler Centre.

Organised by the Fijian Community Association and Churches Unite, all proceeds from the event will go to rebuilding schools that were destroyed by the cyclone through the Fijian Government's "Adopt a School Programme".
